

## Why Is Expository Preaching Important?

In Matthew 28:16-20, we have what is known as the Great Commission. Here, we find that Jesus is very clear that we are to teach His disciples "...to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you."

Notice the word "all." As leaders, we have an awesome responsibility to do just that – to teach all that we have been commanded. To do so, we must be faithful to the whole counsel of God.

Verse by verse preaching does just that. It gives solid spiritual food to the soul of man and nothing can meet man's deepest needs more than the faithful teaching and preaching of God's Word.

Regardless of how the world changes around us, the faithful reliability of God's Word is what the saints of God need. It is like a true friend who tells you what you *need* to hear versus what you *want* to hear. A preacher should give people the truth and nothing but the truth.

Expository preaching helps to meet the deepest need of man's soul. Much is at stake and sound biblical preaching matters.

- It exhorts us to be faithful (Acts 20:17-38, 1 Timothy 4:6, 11-13, 16; 2 Timothy 3:10, 14-17; 4:1-5).
- It saves the lost (Romans 10:17; 1 Timothy 4:16).
- It empowers the saved (Ephesians 4:11-14; Galatians 5:13, Ephesians 4:32, Hebrews 3:13, 10:24; Romans 1:16; Colossians 4:5; 1 Corinthians 16:13).
- It purifies the church (Luke 14:25-35).
- It impacts the future (Acts 2:40-41).

**May our Lord use this conference to help us be ever bold to speak His Word without fear and in truth and able to say with Paul, "For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain. But if I live in the flesh, this is the fruit of my labor" (Philippians 1:21-22a).**

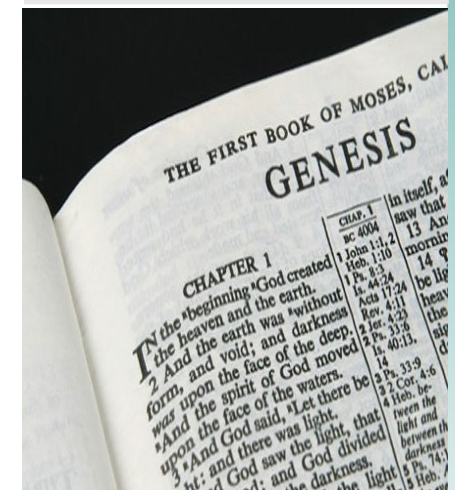
