In what we often call the Great Commission in Matthew 28:19-20, we are told, "Go ye therefore, ...teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you..."

Thus, we see the need for both Christ-centered preaching and Christ-centered living. In 2 Timothy 4:2a Paul instructs Timothy to "preach the word" which is the revelation of Jesus Christ: "Search the scriptures; ...they are they which testify of Me" (John 5:39).

Since "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness" (2 Timothy 3:16), then sound biblical exegesis is necessary for our knowing Christ rightly in order to pursue God's holiness.
